Andrea Sanchez Receives SHPE Dissertation Fellowship

Sponsored by the SHPE foundation, the competitive award recognizes deserving Latino graduate students who demonstrate both significant scholarly accomplishments and high aptitude for a career in science, technology, engineering or mathematics.

Andrea has held several leadership positions with SHPE, including National Graduate Representative for the 2012-2013 academic year and SHPE Regional 7 Graduate Representative. She is advised by **Alberto A. Sagüés**, Distinguished University Professor in the Civil and Environmental Engineering Department.
